Sacred Heart Flea Market Exhibitor/Vendor Guidelines

By submitting this exhibitor/vendor application form, participants agree to abide by all Rules and Regulations of Sacred Heart, Glyndon. Non-profit spaces are provided free of charge.

Children and youth groups are welcome to participate, but must be accompanied by an adult or adult representatives who are responsible for their behavior, actions, liabilities, etc.

Space rentals may not be canceled and there are no refunds or credits issued for unused rent.

The event will be held rain or shine, however, will be moved to the school gym in the event of inclement weather. Small pop-up tents are allowed outside, but must be indicated on the application form. No tent or umbrella will be allowed without previous approval.

All business or other activity for which vendor has rented space must be conducted within the assigned table area only. Distribution, layout, or hanging of any items outside the assigned table area is not permitted. You must bring your own table(s) or a 6-ft. table can be rented from us for an additional \$10.00.

NO item may be displayed or sold that Sacred Heart, Glyndon feels is in poor taste or does not reflect a positive image for the church and school. Sacred Heart has the express right to say what CAN OR CANNOT be sold at the Flea Market at any time.

Dealers should dispose of ALL trash in the garbage cans provided. Please do not use the dumpster on the parking lot. ALL boxes should be flattened or filled with other trash to help maximize the capacity of the cans and all unsold items and vendor paraphernalia must be removed from the premises at the close of the flea market.
