COURSE DESCRIPTION

The Catechesis of the Good Shepherd is an approach to the religious formation of children, 3-12 years of age, based on the conviction that God and the child are in a loving relationship.

At the heart of the catechetical work for the LII child is the image Jesus gives of our relationship with him: I am the Vine; you are the branches (Jn 15:1-11).

The Level I course is the foundation for all three levels of the Catechesis of the Good Shepherd and is the prerequisite for this LII course.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

- * To explore the general developmental and religious characteristics of the 6-9 year old child.
- * To facilitate further meditation upon the biblical and liturgical themes of the Catechesis.
- * To examine the Sacramental Prep model developed by Sofia Cavalletti and practical implementation in your Parish.
- * To offer guidelines and assistance to catechists in setting up an atrium, preparing an album and making materials.
- * To deepen participants' ability to observe and learn from children.
